Policies include:


- Assessing energy usage and its environmental impact.
- Tracking CO2 emissions from transportation, including vehicles.
- Promoting environment-friendly transportation methods such as bicycles, public transit, and pedestrian-friendly roads to reduce local air pollution.
- Installing photovoltaic solar panels for alternate energy generation.
- Implementing LED bulbs campus-wide to save energy.
- Establishing a systematic waste management mechanism.
- Developing rainwater harvesting systems.
- Undertaking tree plantation drives.
- Continuously improving energy consumption through additional measures.
- Ensuring resources are available to achieve objectives.
- Encouraging the use of advanced technology to minimize energy consumption, emissions, and noise, especially in vehicle fleets.
- Collaborating with government agencies, municipal corporations, the affiliating university, and local organizations on environmental, energy efficiency, and sustainable development initiatives.
